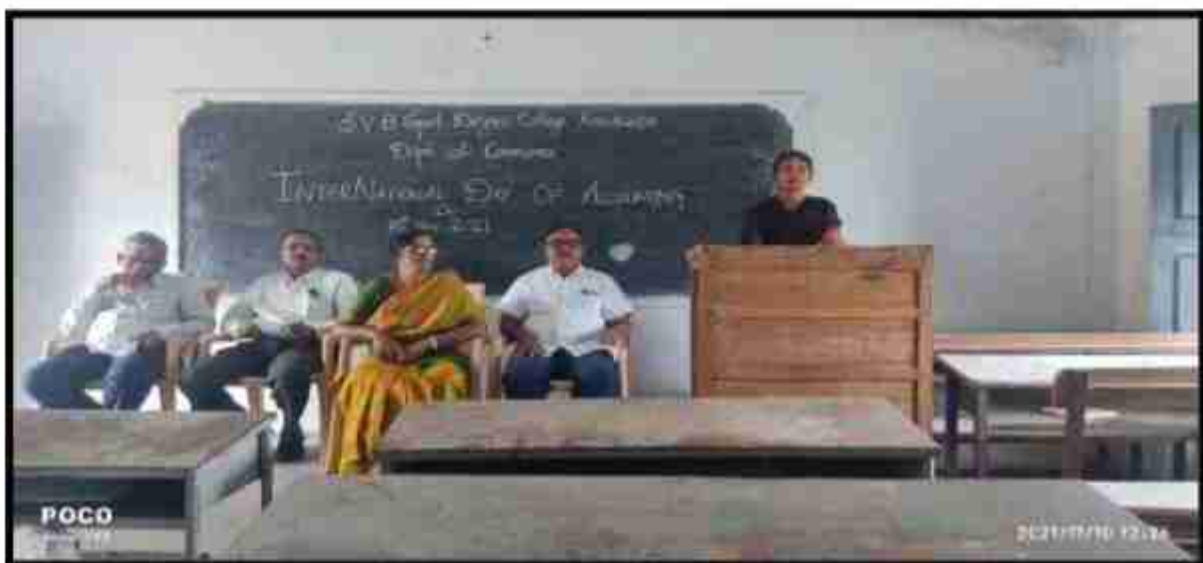
Title of the Programme Organized:

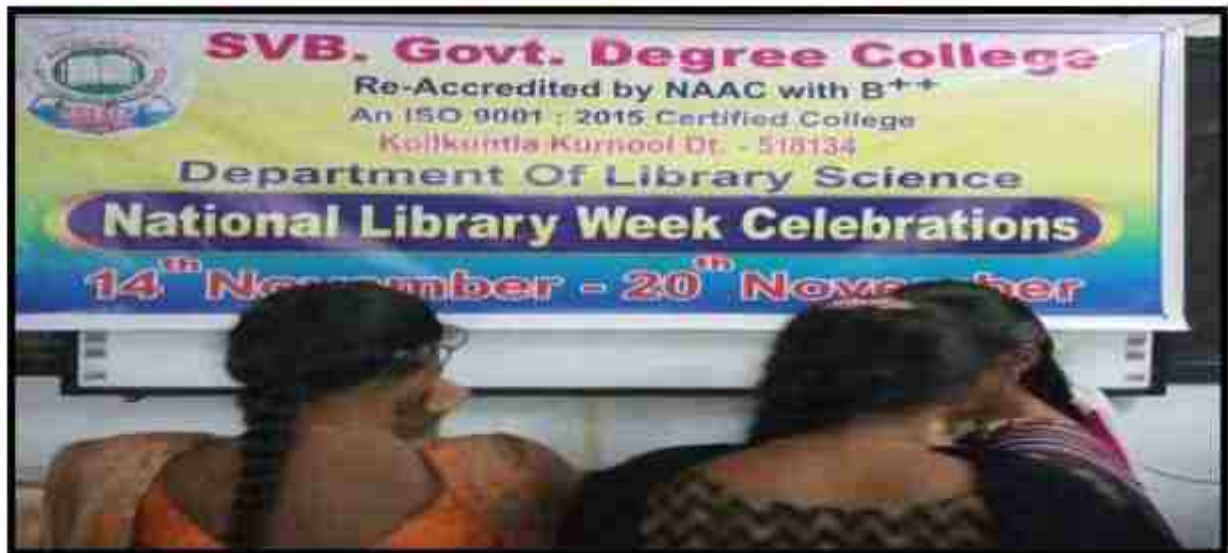
“Library Week”

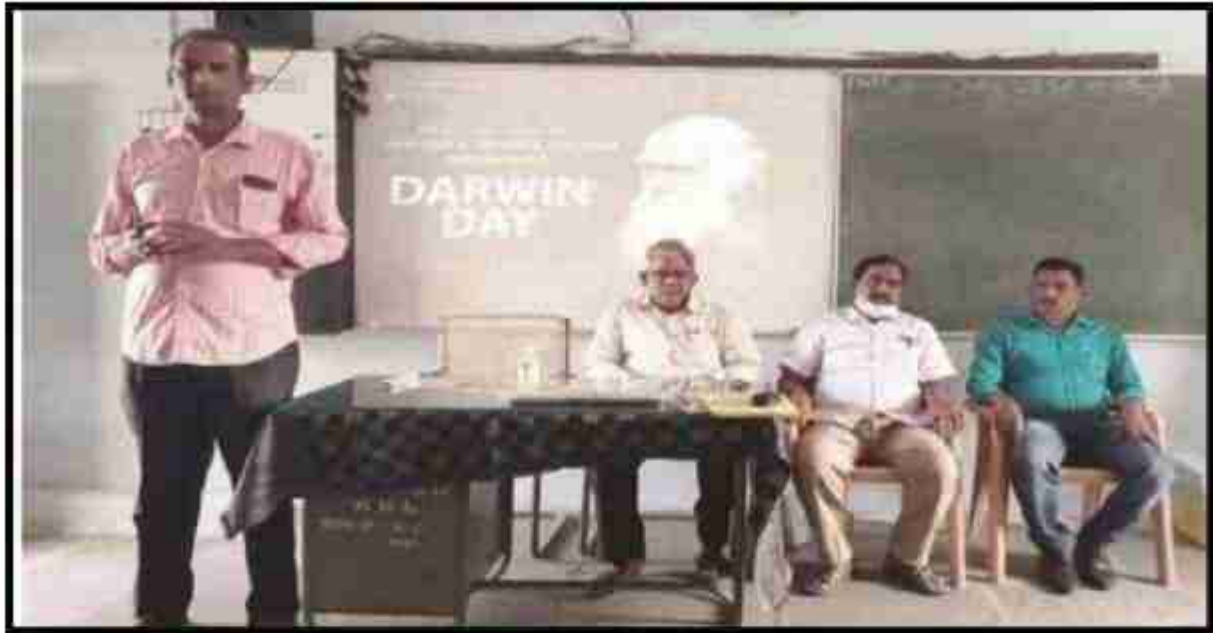
“International Darwin Day”

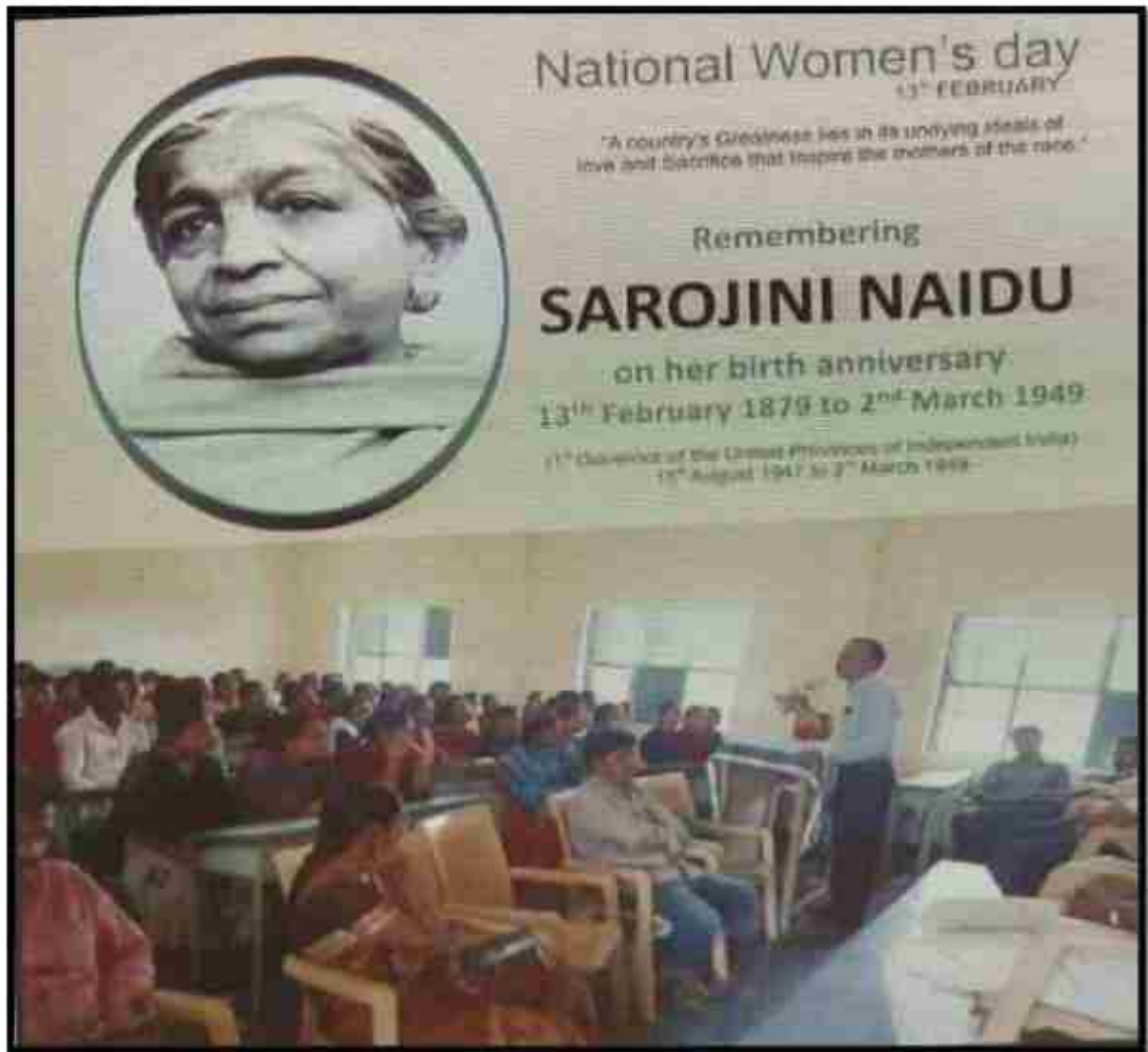
